Ussel placed on ship way, when a new propeller and screw shaft were fitted and properly secured. All sea connections overhauled and examined. No other parts of machinery opened up for inspection at this time.

As it was uncertain where the above mentioned shaft was to be fitted the Forging Report for same was sent to London on the 27th Sept 1887.
