REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Completion of S.S. No 3
 The after cross bunker cleared. The ceiling renewed. The plating, frames re chipped, scraped & repainted. Some of the close ceiling in Bunker, parts of the plating at bottom, several ribs & parts of horizontal & vertical stiffening angles to Bunkers & angles to one Beam renewed. The floors coated with cement wash. Part of the close ceiling in Bunker renewed remainder replaced.
 On main deck at sides of E & B. Hway, two plates on port side & one on starboard with 1100 ft 3 1/2 pitch pine deck flat renewed.
