
REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Damage caused by groundaft &c.*  
 One plate in C. stoke post side forward renewed & one in D. stoke set fair in place.  
 The outside repainted.  
 The angle iron to four hold beams partly renewed & a pair of diagonal tie plates fitted to these beams abaft main hatchway.  
 Eight planks in deck star each side of Boiler hatchway and 15 ft of angle iron to Conning & tie plate starboard side renewed. Four bunker stays renewed & bunker plating patched.
