REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage stated to have been caused by collision at Bilbao by grounding.

Now done :- Three plates in stem, one in stumper plate port side aft & two plates starboard side aft of R. 2nd removed also eight feet of gunwale angle iron. 3 1/2 ft of bulwark rail & 4 1/2 ft of angle to same, two square stranchions & 19 guard stranchions repaired. The steering gear repaired. One indented fair plate port side, 1 1/2 ft from aft, taken off set fair renewed in place and an outside strap fitted at its forebulk. Several bulks in bottom cleaned out & cemented and the bottom recoated.
