REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR

Part special Survey No. 2

Now done Holds No. 2. No. 3 (Spare cross bunkers) and No. 5, & the fore Cross bunker cleared; the bunker boards & ceiling, in excess of the Rule requirement, now removed. All iron work at these parts cleaned & examined & recoated. Cement-tested. Ceilings 120 ft. of 2 1/2" of Ceiling renewed remainder relaid. Thru-chain cables ranged & these with anchors & general equipment examined.

For completion of survey the following still remains to be done. The vessel examined in dry dock. No. 1 & 2 holds to be cleared & ceiling, as per rule removed also the side bunkers & tween deck & the fore & after peaks cleared & prepared for examination.
