REPAIRS, & EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Half-Time Survey.
Repairs on account of worming.
The outside planking renewed with pitch pine from keel to a perpendicular height of 8'-6" from lower edge of rabbet of keel. The bottom and outside recaulked in way of the repairs.

Half-Time Survey.
In addition to the above repairs, a few trenails removed in the topsides; the windlass unhung; the chain cables ranged; the masts, spars, and general equipment examined; and all the requirements of the Rules for the Half-Time Survey complied with.
The fore yard renewed.
