RS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR

On visiting this vessel intimation was made to the owners' superintendent, Mr Sheriff - that she was due for S.S. No. 2, but he stated that she was then being examined by the representatives of an Italian firm, with the view to her purchase & who intended, in case of obtaining possession to allow the class to lapse. It appears that no decision has yet been arrived at but that a definite answer is expected soon.

Now done three plates in E Strake (on outside) in the port bow, referred to in Glasgow Rep No 10109, now renewed & the outside repainted but the inside not having been prepared no part of the S.S. No. 2 now done.

General Observations, Opinion as to Class, Recommendation, &c. :-

State clearly whether any and, if so, what alteration is suggested to be made in the existing classification and notification of the vessel in the Register Book consequent upon this survey, thus, for example: - "to remain as now classed in the Register Book without fresh record of Survey," "to remain as classed and to have record of survey, 9,91," or "to remain as classed and to have record of survey, 9,91, and the notations of ss No. 1-91 and ptND91, &c."

This vessel appears to be in good condition, and under the circumstances stated above recommend that the class be continued in the Ref Book, but, in consideration of the S.S. No. 2 being now overdue, not to have fresh record of survey.
