REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR

Part Special Survey No 2  
Now done. The holds & stowage cleared, the timber boards, Ceiling hatches and a few of the fastened planks of the close ceiling, altogether amounting to more than the required three strokes, removed all fore & aft in these compartments each side, and the parts of floors, reverses and cement, thereby exposed, together with the inside of shell plating, frames reverses, above bulges, the keelsons, stringers, beams, bulkheads &c examined. The upper deck flat, also the mast & wedges of which were removed, & the spars & rigging examined.

For Completion. It is required to have the following parts examined:— The outside of vessel in dry dock, the Coal bunkers and the parts under the Engines & Boilers, after being cleared & cleaned, and the Chain cables to be ranged. This work the owners propose doing at Shanghai or Hong Kong, during voyage.
