Repairs Caused by deterioration

The outside scammored, scraped & repainted.  
 The whole of the close ceiling in the main hold renewed of 2 1/2 pitch pine, also a large portion of the sparring of 2 white pine. Three hold beams, and the angles to the others renewed. New intermediate beams of 7 x 5 x 7/16 angle bulbs now fitted. Coatings to lower main hatchway, & two plates at after end of hold each side to the lower deck stringers renewed, and a new deck flat laid of 3 white pine. Five new pillars fitted & set straightened. Twelve feet of new rudder plate fitted under main hatchway to middle line keelson. Two new bronze pipes fitted. The former ones were fitted below upper deck & the holes have now been efficiently closed by means
