REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage caused by collision

At after end of poop on starb^d side, one half round plate and two counter plates renewed; one counter plate taken off faired and replaced, four stern frames renewed; two new lengths of poops covering board, about 80 ft. of poop deck renewed, and poop deck recaulked on the starb^d side. steering gear overhauled.
