This vessel has been placed on slipway the bottom, cleared, examined and recoated. One deck plate on port side of fore hatchway and one at heel of ladder to bridge deck on port side fitted with a doubling plate through being thin, several rivets in main deck renewed, one plate at after end of Bridge house on Starboard side set fair in place and fitted with a doubling plate in one space.
