The machinery opened up throughout, and the cylinders, pistons slide valves, all crank and tunnel shafting (excepting propeller), air circulating, bilge & feed pumps examined. The feed pump plungers have been turned true and their glands bushed, one new bilge pump plunger now fitted, and the keeps on tunnel shafting bearing repaired.

The two main boilers and their safety valves examined.

The donkey boiler and its safety valves examined.

Steam was raised in the main & donkey boilers, and their safety valves adjusted to 85 & 70 lb. per sq" respectively.

## General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:—The machinery of this vessel,
