On port side in stateroom at upper turn of bilge vessel is indented in three places, one abreast foremast one in Engine space and one abreast main mast, she has also an indent in flat of bottom on port side in way of after hold. The owner intends to make good these indents and complete survey at Antwerp for which port she has now sailed, and the Antwerp Surveyors have been advised accordingly.

This vessel sailed from here before the Bilbao Rept. No. 612 arrived, the same has been returned herewith.
