## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

**RUBY.**—Rosslare, Wexford, Nov. 15, 9 35 a.m.—Ruby barque, of Belfast, official No. 60,834, discharging timber alongside Ballygeary Pier, carried away bow moorings, swung round, and struck against piles and sank; upper deck just awash.

**RUBY.**—Wexford, Nov. 15, 11 23 a.m.—Ruby, from Miramichi, timber, burst from Rosslare pier. Fast to buoy, full of water, striking the ground.

**RUBY.**—Wexford, Nov. 17, 12 25 p.m.—Ruby towed afloat by tug Wrestler. Now berthed at Rosslare Pier to discharge deckload.

## Particulars of Casualty

Vessel was discharging timber alongside pier at Rosslare, co. Wexford, on 15th November. The bow moorings carried away, and the vessel swung round, struck against the piles and sank, her upper deck being just awash. Two days later the vessel was refloated and again berthed at the pier. No casualty notice has been sent to the owners, but, as the vessel has been submerged, the circumstances are reported to the Committee.

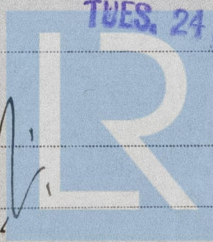
