Bottom cleaned, examined and recoated.
On Starb. side at stem - One plate of sheerstrake, one side plate of forecathle and doubler in way of lower pipe, also one plate of forecathle sheer renewed through being badly indented.
On port side at stem - One plate of sheerstrake, one side plate of forecathle, one upper plate of forecathle and one doubling plate in way of lower pipe taken off, faired and replaced.
Upper part of stem set fair in place.


