IS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage, stated to have been caused by collision with the steamer "Instantinos" off Hockington on July 24th 1898.

Ship's Upon examination of the vessel it was found that the plating and frames on the port bow were set in and the following repairs were recommended, viz:— The 2nd and 3rd plates in the strake next below the fore-castle sheerstrake, on the port side, to be removed, rolled and replaced; the upper edge of the next strake below to be faired in place; one frame to be faired in place; two frames to be cut above the main deck and partly renewed, efficient connections to be made by boom pieces; one beam knee to be unriveted, faired in place and riveted; the fresh water tank to be refastened; the woodwork of water-closet moved in effecting the repairs to be replaced or renewed as found necessary; the repairs to be recoated.

The repairs are to be done at Carston, for which place the vessel has sailed. The Liverpool Surveyors have been notified. No information could be obtained regarding the completion of Special Survey No. 1.

The vessel being loaded the hold was only partly examined.
