When vessel was in dry dock the propeller & sea cock fastenings were examined. found the shaft down about 1/16" and the fastenings of donkey boiler blow off cock defective. The propeller shaft has been drawn in, examined and found in good condition, the stern bush re-lined and the donkey boiler blow off cock re-jointed, also four new blades fitted on propeller boss.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation: The machinery of this vessel so far as seen, is in good condition and is eligible in my opinion to remain as classed in register book.
