Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo from which I note that the space immediately under the Shelter Deck of the steamer "CUMBERLAND" (Messrs. W. Hamilton & Co's No. 299) has not been provided with cargo battens because you contemplate continuing the insulation in this space at an early date.

In the circumstances it will be necessary for the notation:- "Cargo battens not fitted in upper tween decks" to be made on the certificate of classification and in the Register Book, but this notation will of course be removed as soon as the insulation of the upper tween decks is completed.

The Society's Surveyors at Greenock are being duly advised of your intentions in the matter.
