REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR *Locking*

Bottom examined and recoated, rudder pinches bushed. Flaws having developed on each side of sole piece of cast steel stern frame in a line with the after edge of the inner post has now been repaired by fitting efficient steel blank plates 1 1/2" thick on each side of stern frame. A bilge keel has been fitted on each side of vessel 140 ft long formed of 4 x 4 x 1/2 angles and a plate 12" x 1/2"
