Sir. We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th Ult, and enclosed forward a tracing descriptive of the present deck arrangements of the Composite Ship "Antonia"; The Angle Bar Beams marked A on tracing are in accordance with the Owners proposition, and as shown all the Diagonal Plates are in the way of same, also some Strakes of Deck are fitted as Binding Strakes, the lower parts of which come on the Beams and are also in the way.

The Deck is at present quite close to the Beams, and we are of opinion that the through fastening previously suggested, viz, one in each plank through the Oak lining pieces on Beams, and as many as

practicable through the Diagonal
Ties on Beams, and found there being
double the quantity of through fastenings
as compared with the first recommen-
dation we are of opinion that the same
may be deemed efficient, providing
it meets with the Committee's
approval.
