Your telegram of the 1st Inst, regarding the S.S. "Egeron" has been communicated to the Directors of the Neth. Ind. Handels-Bank here, at whose request the enquiry about the classification was made.

This Company however - who is much interested in the said Steamer - desired me yesterday to beg that you would be kind enough to state the additions you require in this Steamer, both for hull and equipment, as they would be glad to know exactly the reasons owing to which the Master, Mr Vetter (under whose care she was built and completed at Glasgow) could not get a Lloyd's Certificate, which the Owners and other parties here expected to be on board the vessel. -

She is now loaded with a general cargo here for Java and ready for sea.
