## REPORT ON SHIP FORGINGS.

Sir,

I beg leave to report that the undermentioned Forgings, manufactured by *Messrs Dixon & Co (Ld)* of *Glasgow* for the Vessel No. 118, being built by *Messrs Aitken & Mansell* of *Glasgow* have been inspected by me in course of being forged and smithed, and found to be, so far as can be seen, *sound*. The taper in the port and two stays, was not regular, but the frame was clear of flaws or surface defects.
