Lower Sepsail 2 plates in the round of steel.
Same $\frac{1}{2}$ " single riveted.
rivets $\frac{1}{4}$ " Butts double-riveted
doubling plates at slings to catenoid beyond brass hoop
plates $\frac{1}{8}$ " to $\frac{3}{16}$ " at ends.

Sawyer yard 2 plates in the round of steel
seams $\frac{1}{2}$ " single riveted.
rivets $\frac{3}{4}$ " butts double riveted.
doubling plates at strops to extend beyond truss knots
plates $\frac{3}{4}$ " to $\frac{1}{2}$ " at ends

No:- Masts three plates in the round of heel
beams $\frac{1}{2}$ " double riveted to keel
 $\frac{1}{2}$ " single above
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rivets in $\frac{1}{2}$ " plates and all thicker
 $\frac{1}{8}$ " $\frac{1}{32}$ " thinner
Buttresses belts riveted $\frac{7}{8}$ " thicker than their plates above deck
deck below deck
Drumming plates at deck & rigging tops
Plate $\frac{1}{2}$ " at heel $\frac{1}{2}$ " at deck $\frac{1}{2}$ " mast; $\frac{1}{2}$ " mainmast at deck,
 $\frac{1}{2}$ " $\frac{1}{2}$ " at foremast $\frac{1}{2}$ " head $\frac{1}{2}$ " above head to $\frac{1}{2}$ " remainder
Masts 5 diameters apart.
