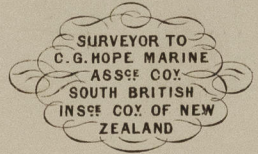
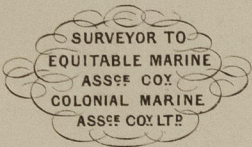

I had this pleasure on the 28<sup>th</sup> Ult<sup>m</sup>  
since then nothing of importance has trans-  
pired worthy of reporting & accepting that the  
Borghese arrived here from Simon's  
Bay on Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> Ult<sup>m</sup> at noon -  
and left the Alfred Dock round eastward  
on Saturday evening at 8.30 - without  
effecting the alterations to her funnels  
or doing anything towards it <sup>even seeing the</sup>  
During the time the vessel was  
here I called on board and did  
not see him - I called at the agents  
office with the same result. I sent  
him a note press copy remark  
enclosed marked B & also I notified  
him while he was lying in Simon's Bay  
and which was never replied to, the  
press copy of this letter was forwarded  
to you by last mail. and I expressed  
myself as willing to supervise the  
repair or alterations on condition that  
he would defray travelling expenses.

The Captain called for London and

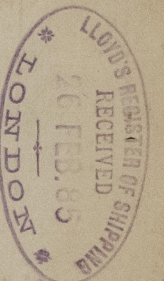
