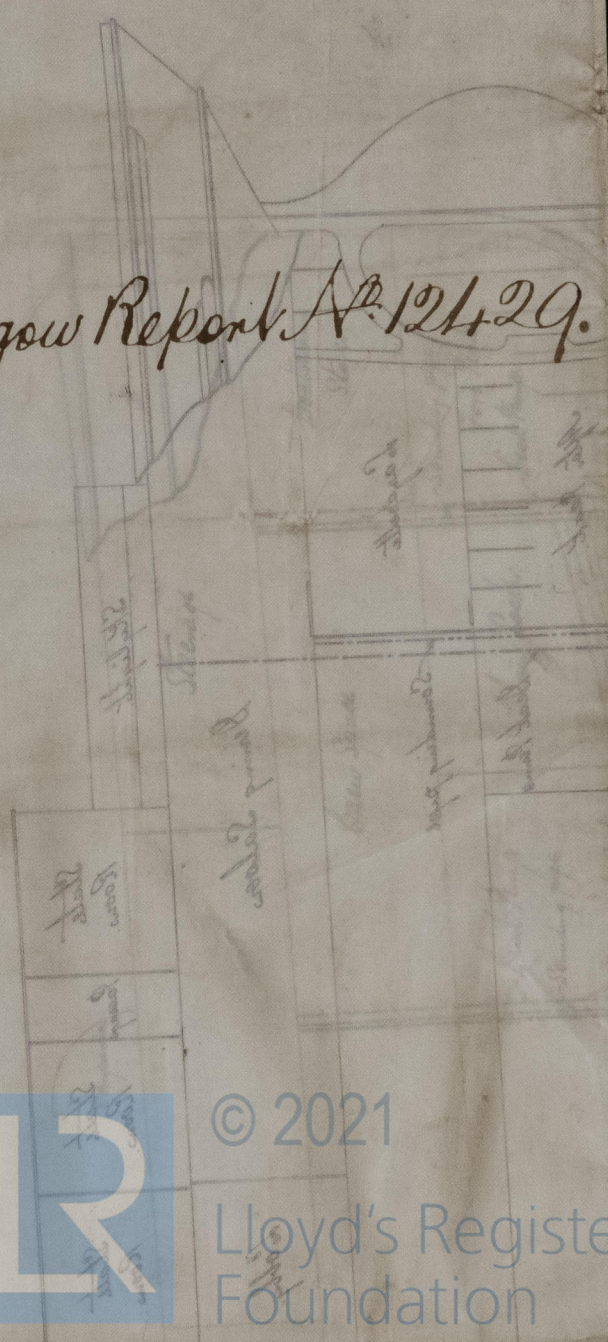


Hand-drawn plan of the ship "SS. Albatross" showing the deck layout, compartments, and structural details. The plan includes the following labeled areas:
