Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 21st. instant, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbro', respecting the survey of the boilers of your steamer "DORSET", I am directed to point out that although this vessel's boilers were only fitted in the vessel in 1894, they were commenced in 1885, and finished in 1889, and that although they were in good condition when fitted they could hardly be expected to be in such perfect condition as boilers really new, as the tubes, stays, and internal plates would necessarily slightly deteriorate.

The Committee had the case under consideration at their meeting this morning, as regards the survey of these boilers, and I am directed to state that, under the circumstances, it is considered that they should be submitted for survey in 1898, upon the occasion of the S.S. No. 1, which will then become due, and that subsequently they should be surveyed annually.

I trust this arrangement will be satisfactory to you.

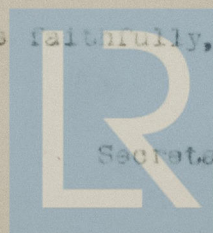
