I beg to submit
for the consideration of the Committee
a letter received by Mr J. H. Gilmour
from Mr John Green, Chain maker
near Dudley, respecting the weight of
the 9/16" close link stream chain, supplied
to Mr Gilmour for the S. S. No 20 now building
at Irvine.

It will be observed the weight is 25 lbs less
than given in Table 22, with five feet excess
of length. The stud link chain cable is
2. 26 excess weight. In view of the
weight of the main chain cable I beg to be
informed whether the stream chain will be
accepted.
