Sir

In reply to the inquiries contained in your letter of the 20th inst. having reference to Glasgow Survey Report No 13536 on the steel s.s. "Semiramis". I beg respectfully to state that the length of double bottom under engines of that vessel is 54 ft and of the double bottom under boilers is 52 ft: so that the ~~total~~ length of the two divisions of double bottom under engines and boilers is 106 ft. and not 52 feet as stated in the report.

The exact length of No 4 compartment of double bottom is 73 feet. 8 inches. and not 72 ft as stated in the report.

The moulded depth to main deck is 22 ft. 9 in and the size of the lower chain cable is $2\frac{3}{16}$ in.

The builders desire me to state, they will be glad if you will kindly let the certificates of classification reach this office on Saturday, 23rd inst.
