Dear Sirs,

With reference to the case of your steamer "COLINA" in which, as the vessel was lying up, the Committee agreed to allow her class to remain undisturbed in the Society's Register Book on the conditions set forth in my letters of the 16th & 19th May, 1893, I beg to draw your attention to the fact that the Second Special Survey No.3 has become due on the hull & machinery.

As the vessel appears to be still lying up in the Gareloch the Committee will be agreeable to allow her character to remain undisturbed in the Society's Register Book upon your undertaking that she will be submitted to Special Survey No.3 before she is again sent to sea by you, and that in the event of her being offered for sale or of the existing Owners' interest in her being otherwise transferred, you will inform intending purchasers and similarly interested parties that this is a condition of her classification.

Upon the expiration of the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Special Survey No.3, viz.,
