This vessel has been lying up in the Gareloch since December, 1892. In May, 1893, the Owners gave an undertaking that in the event of their being successful in effecting a sale they would advise intending purchasers, ^{as to the condition of class} and that if the vessel were sailed on their own account the Boiler Survey would take place before she again proceeded to sea. In January last the case was submitted to the Chairman, and it was decided that no action should be taken for the present. From a letter recently received from the Society's Surveyors at Glasgow it appears that the vessel is still lying up in the Gareloch.
