SURVEY PARTLY HELD.

Portion of Survey held, &c.

The S.S.No.3 became due in May last.

In September last the vessel changed Ownership, and the bottom was examined in dry dock as part of the survey, *and Boiler Survey held.* At that time the Owners wished to postpone the completion of the survey on the hull for about two months, during which time it was intended to make two voyages to Iceland, and then lay the vessel up for survey. This was approved by the Committee on the 8th. October last.

In reply to enquiry the Glasgow Surveyors now state that the vessel is laid up in the Gareloch, and nothing has been done towards the completion of the special survey.

It is submitted the Owner should be reminded of his undertaking to the Glasgow Surveyors in September last to complete the survey in about two months time; and requested to state what action he proposes taking in the matter.

It is submitted that the Glasgow Surveyors should be requested to inform this Office if this vessel is removed from the Gareloch, and that the Owner should not be communicated with at present.
