Nature of Survey Second S.S. No 3 and reclassing—also alterations.

This vessel was formerly classed A.1 in the Register Book, but this class ^{was} subsequently withdrawn. The Second S.S. No. 3 has now been held with a view to the re-instatement of class.

The following repairs effected:— Cement, ceiling, 3 frames, 2 plates, and one bulkhead, repaired: 2 stringer plates, 2 hawsepipes, renewed: one bulkhead partly renewed: one stringer plate doubled.

The plating has been drilled with satisfactory results.

Alterations :- Bridge reduced in length: the main hatch increased in length: the beams in way of same plated over: wood deck at this part renewed: and two additional web plates (making 3 in all) fitted.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to have her class A.1 re-instated in the Register Book, with record 3, 96 Psy. and notation of S.S. Psy. 2nd No. 3-3, 96, also 4BH. Cem., as recommended.
