We confirm wires passed today re above vessel. Ship has only ten loading days at Portland so we will have little or no detention there. As wired you we expect her to arrive in this country about end November and the survey will at once be gone through.

When vessel passed in 1903 survey in London she had a very big overhaul and had nearly all new rigging. Since then ship has been well kept up.

We hope your Committee, under the circumstances will grant us an extension to bring the ship home without incurring the large expense of having a survey in a place like Portland Oregon.
