 and go through Survey there but
 when we arrived we found, owing to
 the hostilities between that country
 and China, that the dry docks were
 all being used by the Government
 so our arrangements fell through.

The ship is on passage to Portland
 (C) from where we have fixed her home
 to C.R. Port. and we will be obliged
 if you will get the permission of the
 Committee to let the Survey stand

over, till then. He may say the
Admiral has had instructions to get
the ship ready for survey and
which he has been doing so we
don't anticipate that there will be
much to do to the ship when she
does come. Ship is in first
class order.
