Messrs Napier, Shanks and Bell
examine the Steel Ship S.S. "Kowai-i-Maru"
5920 tons register, when in the Green Bay Dock,
on the 24th & 25th March 1897, for the purpose
of ascertaining the nature & amount of damage
alleged to have been done to some
of the launching planks adjoining to the
vessel's bottom.

The examination found six planks had
become fast in way of flat steel, amidships.

Recommended that the planks be removed
in order to make an examination of the rivets
& caulking in way of same. This necessitated
the cutting away of six feet or so. These to
be afterwards renewed.

The caulking & rivets of vessel found in
good condition.
