With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of four steamers "ROTOKINO", "MARAROA" and "ROTOHANANA" and to the Special Survey No.2, which became due in May, 1898, on the "ROTOKINO" and to the Special Annual Surveys, which became due on the Boilers of the "MARAROA" and "ROTOHANANA" in October, 1898, I am directed to acquaint you that to entitle these vessels to retain their classes in the Register Book the respective surveys must be held without further delay and that unless this be done before the end of the present year the Committee will have no option but to deal with their classes.

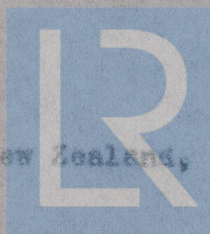
