Sir,

Your letter of 16th June last duly to hand and
contains re steamer "Rotokino", "Macaroa", and "Rotomahana", noted,
and in communication with the owners in the matter I am informed
that the "Rotokino" is plying between Sydney and Fiji, that the rules of the
Society have been complied with in a fragmentary way but not under
the inspection of the Society's Surveyor(s), at same time it is still the
desire of the R.S.S.C. that the existing classification of this vessel be
continued, but for no time (for s.s. No 2) at present. With reference
to the annual survey of the Boilers of the "Macaroa" and "Rotomahana".
the time for such survey may probably be September or October next.

Forward herewith Report No 262 on the S. S. "Macaroa".
I may here mention that the total loss of three of the company's
steamers since December last appears to have disturbed the regular
order (in a measure) of the periodical overhauls to several vessels of their
fleet, not yet replaced. I regret the delay that has arisen in
the non-compliance with the Rule for survey in a reasonable time
of several of the steamers in the fleet, but am doing my best endeavour
to keep the owners up to rule.
