

EXTRACT from a letter from the Society's Surveyor at Danedin,  
dated 8th June 99.

The Union S.S.Co. is now distributing its work of repairs to the  
fleet more over the Australian ports than formerly at Port Chalmers  
(Head Quarters) & the Marine Supt. now informs me that the S.S.No.2  
on the "ROTORINO" (Long overdue) will be attended to early at Sydney,  
the Annual S.S. in the "ROTORAHANA" to be made at Lyttleton early, & on  
the boiler of the "MARAHOA" early, but at what port not decided. I will  
advise the Surveyors at Sydney & Lyttleton of the present  
intention of the U.S.S.Co. respecting the vessels referred to.
