"Rotokino" S.S. With reference to this vessel, as quoted to you in my letter of 15th August last, was docked in November last but no time given to make the special survey N^o 2. there being a business pressure on requiring her back into active service without delay, and having a desire at all times to work in harmony with the Union Steamship Coy. consistent with the due observance of the Society's rules, I made no objections, the Marine Superintendent promising that the survey would be made in May first, at which date the N.Z. government Engineer's annual inspection will be due.

"Kauaro" S.S. This vessel according to promise is to be docked in April first when the second special survey N^o 1. will be held.

"Wanaka" S.S. The annual survey of the Boilers of this vessel will be made in April first, according to promise.

"Overcargill" S.S. The annual survey of the Boilers of this vessel will be made during the current month.

"Wolseley" S.S. In reply to your letter of 9th Dec. last (initial as/s margin) re the Boiler survey of this vessel, I learn from the Owner that there was no survey held on same by an independent Surveyor, but a survey has been made quite recently by the Government Engineer Inspector, to whom I will write for a certificate on same.

This vessel came from the Bluff Harbour for her annual overhaul in the Dry Dock before her due time, April, and at the request of the Captain (Mr. Donald) the annual survey of the Vessel was made and herewith send the Engineer Surveyor's Report on same, also enclose, press copy of certificate issued to the Owner.

3. *repacked* "De Amarr" S.S. In reply to Your letter of 16th Dec. last (Initial as/s margin) re this vessel, I beg to state that the removal of the screw & shaft was in consequence of it being too small, and the boss of the propeller & split. They were both renewed without my knowledge, the matter not having been brought under my notice.
