Sir.

Enclosed I have the pleasure
to forward the Survey Report of
the barque Quakamba. Mr Craig the Owner also
informs me that he intends to alter the Rig
of the Margarita into a Barque. I also send
Copies of Reports on the Wacmate near Chamber
Barquentine Margarita and Ship Republic.

[S1] Your letter of the 2nd Feb 1900. I have
acquainted the Union Steam Ship Co. D. at their Port
of the purpose of it. They state that the vessel will
now run between Australia and Tasmania. At
present they cannot tell whether any of the proposed
requirements will be carried out, only that the New
Rudder will be shipped. To my mind they do
not appear to care whether their vessels are in
the Class or not. The Manapouri was docked
here for clearing the other day. Her time for Survey
has expired. They would not have her Surveyed.
In fact, Mr Henderson - who has been removed from the Management here
for a short time to Tasmania - informed me, that it was the intention
of the Company, not to continue the vessels in the Class.
