I have to acquaint you that I am informed by the Surveyors at Glasgow that a new rudder has been made for the Steamer "Katoctine" & has been forwarded to your port where it is considered it will be fitted.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case attention.

The following remains to be done to complete the Special Survey No 2 due May 1891 viz: coal bunkers to be cleared & examined, scotling in same lifted as per Rule, 8 & B space, after peak, pumps & water tight doors to be examined, length & size of cables on board reported, fore peak to be chipped and painted & scotling to be removed from the tank top and the tank.
