"The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

Nature of Survey New Rudder. S.S. No. 2 due 5.98 part held

The Glasgow Surveyors forward a report on a rudder which has been made under their inspection and which is to be forwarded to Sydney to be fitted to this vessel.

The S.S.No.2 became due in „ May 1898 and was partly held at Auckland in November last.

The case which is fully stated on the endorsement dated 27.1.00 was before the Committee on the 2nd ultimo and the Surveyor was written to and requested to communicate with the Owners or their Representatives and to arrange definitely for the survey to be completed without further delay, as unless this were done the Committee would have no option but to deal with the vessel's class.

As sufficient time has not yet elapsed for receipt of a reply from the Auckland Surveyor it is submitted that action be deferred. The Sydney Surveyor however should be advised with reference to the rudder.
