This vessel is a duplicate of the Ferry Steamer now at work on the River Clyde, and the Owners representative states that the anchor and chain cable are now required. The voyage from start to finish only lasts about three minutes, is across the river in the Harbour of Glasgow and the depth of the river at this part is about 26 feet. It is respectfully
