Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting your steamer "OCAMO", and in reply to your inquiry I beg to explain that in order to complete the Second Special Survey No.3 of this vessel partly held at Glasgow in June, 1900, the close ceiling at the bilges required to be removed and the strakes of plating drilled from the cement to the deck.

As the cement may possibly terminate below the upper part of the close ceiling at the bilge, it would in that case be necessary to drill the plating to that extent below the close ceiling.

I should add that the only drillings of the plating made on the occasion of the survey held at Glasgow were in the bunkers and machinery space on account of local deterioration in way of worn cement.
