Sir,

With reference to the case of the steamer "OGAMO", No.3 in the Supplement, I have to acquaint you that the Second Special Survey No.3, which became due in August last, was held at Glasgow in June, 1900, except as regards the removal of the close coiling at the bilges and the drilling of the strakes of the plating above the cement.

The Owners now write that they intend to carry out part of these requirements at Halifax and part at Demerara, and I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention and forward to this Office the report of your inspection.

For your information I enclose herewith a copy of a letter addressed to the Owners yesterday, and also an extract from the first entry report on this vessel. You will observe that the screw shaft is now due for survey.
