accordance with instructions contained in the Secretary's letter of 5th October 1908 (E) this second hand boiler has now been weighed & the dimensions, scantlings & details of shell riveting stained & compared with the original approved plan of the r. The CE sides, bottoms, backs & tops, the furnaces, tubes & end plate full screwed stays are new, the marks on new plates & furnaces have been found to correspond with steel advice note sent herewith. The port CE back having made too short to allow two of the back end plate stays to enter in the CE back, a large riveted doubler has now fitted to the end plate as compensation. The boiler was made tested to 30 lbs net pressure, was gauged at that pressure, and no signs of weakness & no tight & satisfactory.

Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:-

any what alteration, if any, is suggested to be made in the existing classification of the vessel's machinery in the Register Book, consequent upon this survey, and also alteration required to be made in the records of the vessel's machinery, boilers, working pressures, &c.: thus, for example, B.S. 9,07, B.E.M.S. 9,07, or L.M.C. 9,07, 11b, F.D., &c.

is boiler is suitable in my opinion for a working pressure 30 lbs per sq inch. It is to be fitted in the steam trawler "Swift" 2028 in the Register Book.
