We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29<sup>th</sup> ultimo, relating to the Barque "Vigo" and to say that neither of us saw the vessel while on Messrs Stephen & Sons Slip, but from the appearance of the Yellow Metal sheathing, trenails, and condition of caulking, &c.; we believe the particulars as named in Mr Birkenmyre's letter relating to repairs decided in July last, to be correct. We also enclose a memorandum received from Messrs Stephen & Sons relating thereto.

The leak spoken of by Mr Birkenmyre did not continue after the vessel came to an anchor.
