

Extract from Mr. Martin's report  
dated August, 1864.

"Two strathes of topsides chiefly of pitch Pine  
the rest of topsides red pine, viz. about 80 feet each  
side which is of the 7A grade." -

"The trenails in the two strathes of topsides are of  
Pitch Pine & Hackmatack not equal in quality  
to the timber required for 8A." -

"Called attention to the Red Pine Planking  
in topsides, and to the Fir trenails as being  
at variance with Rules for 8A, and to an Oak  
Plank inside at Bilge, padded its whole  
length with Fir." -
