



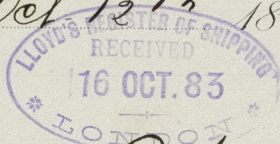

Dear Sirs

Messrs Wallace & Co Lancaster-
field Miller & Co are building
a boiler for the S. S. Cassia
built by Messrs Munro & Murray
of Port Glasgow for our a/c-
(Engineered by Kincaid & Co of
Greenock), and our Marine
Surveyor gives a bad report of
the workmanship, he states the
rivet holes in the shell have not
been drilled in place, & are not
fair, & if they are widened out
till they are fair the strength

at the joints must be con-
siderably weakened he also
states that the flanging of the
front plate is about the worst
workmanship he ever saw
& he also doubts the scantling
being of sufficient strength
according to the dimensions spec-
ified viz (16" 6 dia x 10" 4
3" 3" furnace for 80 lbs pressure-
Will you please see the said
boiler at once & give us your
report. I oblige
