In reply to your inquiry
of yesterday's date - having reference to the
arrangement of Pillars in the Steel Sailing
ship. "British Isles" - built at Port Glasgow in
1884 - I beg respectfully to state that the
quarter pillars in that vessel were fitted
in lieu of, and not in addition to, the
middle line pillars - for half the vessel's
length amidships; and I very much regret
that this fact was not made sufficiently
clear by me in my remarks written
upon the approved midship section.
